## DEER VALLEY: A SHIELD BEARING MINISTRY

In 1 Samuel 14 there is the story of Jonathan and his shield/armour bearer attacking a Philistine outpost. Jonathan led the two of them through difficult ground while seeking God's guidance if they should attack. They were outnumbered and at a disadvantage, being on the low ground. Yet Jonathan believed that the Lord was with them and his shield bearer stood by his side as he followed God's leading.

Shield bearers, in the time of this story, were considered great warriors and had the honour of bearing the armour for others, so that when the battle came the leader (such as Jonathan) was refreshed and ready for the fight. Shield bearers, as in this account, also joined in the battle and had the back of those they served.

This is a great metaphor of DVM. Local churches and ministries are the champions of Christ that we support. We have the backs of those in front line ministries. We provide resources and facilities that ministries could not afford on their own. We believe that God has a great plan for churches and other ministries and our role is to support and resource them.

This is a new way of communicating what has been in the heart of Deer Valley Meadows since the beginning. As we seek what the future holds for DVM, the pathway forward will be shaped by this heart.
